

Woldingham Countryside Circular Walk – Sunday 25th June from 11am

As part of the Trees for Croydon (T4C) campaign, on Sunday 25th June I will be leading a circular walk starting and finishing at Woldingham train station. The walk will start around 11am, though we will wait up to 11:15am in case anyone is late - we won't be able to wait for anyone that arrives later than this, so you'll have to try and find us and catch us up if that happens.

I plan on having a small yellow flag sticking out of the back of my grey rucksack to help people spot me in case useful.

I think the walk is around 4 miles, though don't hold me to this! There is no café or toilets on the route, so you'll need to bring a packed lunch, snacks and liquids etc, and be prepared to answer calls of nature in nature itself. The walk has a bit of uphill and downhill in parts, and is not on even ground, though overall it should be a fairly easy walk for people of average fitness. You'll obviously need to bring suitable clothing etc depending on the weather.

If we finish in time – and hopefully we will – for anyone interested there is The Dene Coffee Shop that is around a 10 minute walk from Woldingham Train Station. The shop closes at 4pm on Sundays.

In case you want to travel in together, I plan on catching the 10:39am train from East Croydon train station on the day, which is due to arrive in Woldingham train station at 10:55am. On the way back there are trains from Woldingham back to East Croydon. People from all teams are naturally welcome, and you can obviously log your active travel under the group you're part of.
